Purposes and legal basis of the data processing:

Data processing is carried out on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (1) (f) GDPR for the following purposes: Exercise of domiciliary rights, property protection (burglary, theft, vandalism) and protection of physical integrity of individuals.

Legitimate interests pursued:

- Deterrence of potential offenders
- Investigation of criminal acts/preservation of evidence
- Enforcement of civil claims/preservation of evidence
- Securing/monitoring of high-risk areas
- Prevention and prosecution of theft, vandalism and burglary
- · Entry and exit control
- Passage right check
- · Access area monitoring

Retention period:

The video recordings are stored for a period of 7 days.

Recipients or categories of recipients of data (if data transfer takes place): Fresenius Group companies at video surveillance sites, service providers for security technology, lawyers, law enforcement agencies, insurance companies.

Information on the rights of data subjects

The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, **access** to these personal data and to the information specified in Art. 15 GDPR.

The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the **rectification** of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her and, if applicable, to have incomplete personal data completed (Art. 16 GDPR).

The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay provided that one of the reasons specified in Art. 17 GDPR applies, e. g., if the data are no longer necessary for the purposes pursued (right to erasure).

The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller **restriction of processing** where one of the conditions specified in Art. 18 GDPR is fulfilled, e. g., if the data subject has objected to processing as long as the examination by the controller takes place.

The data subject has the right to **object**, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her. The controller will no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims (Art. 21 GDPR).

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, every data subject has the **right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority**, if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes the GDPR (Art. 77 GDPR). The data subject can exercise this right with the supervisory authority in the Member State of his or her habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.
