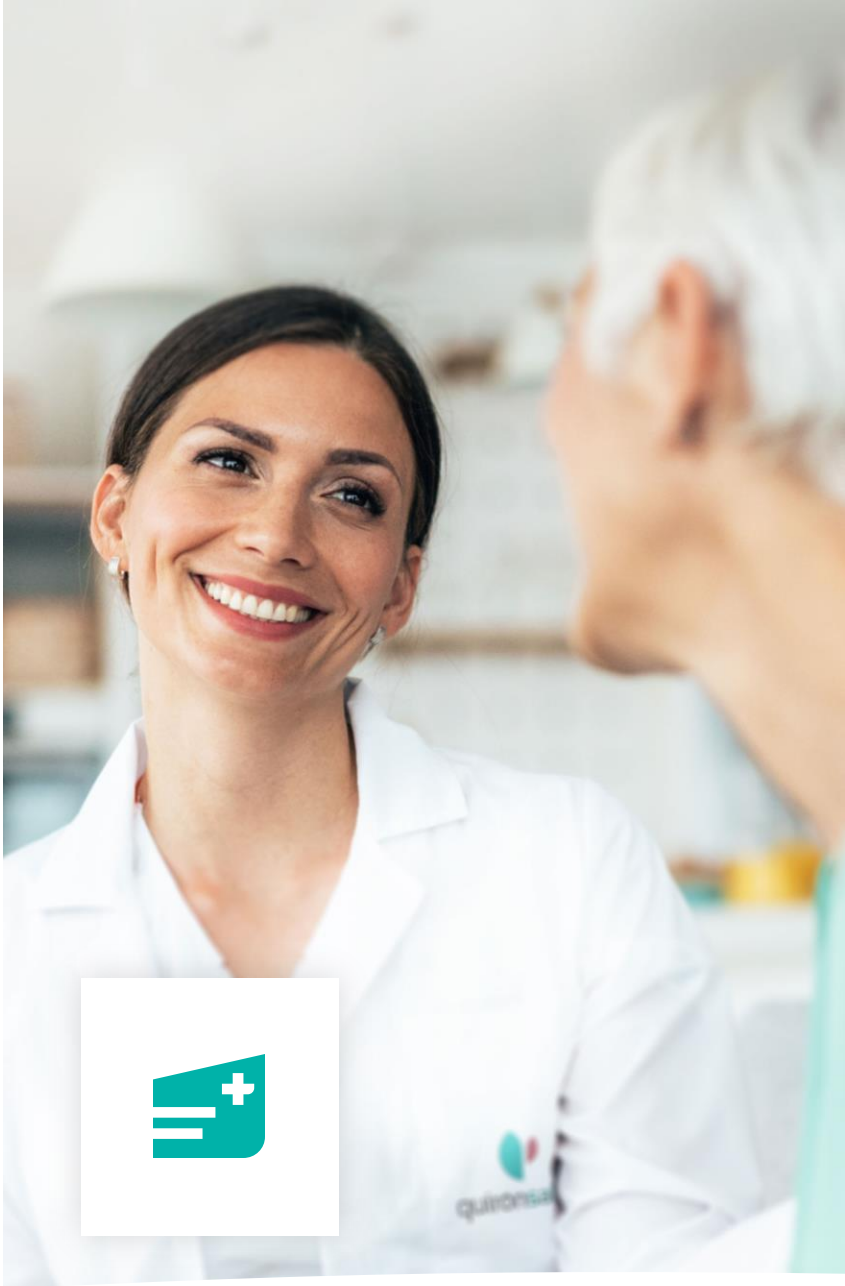

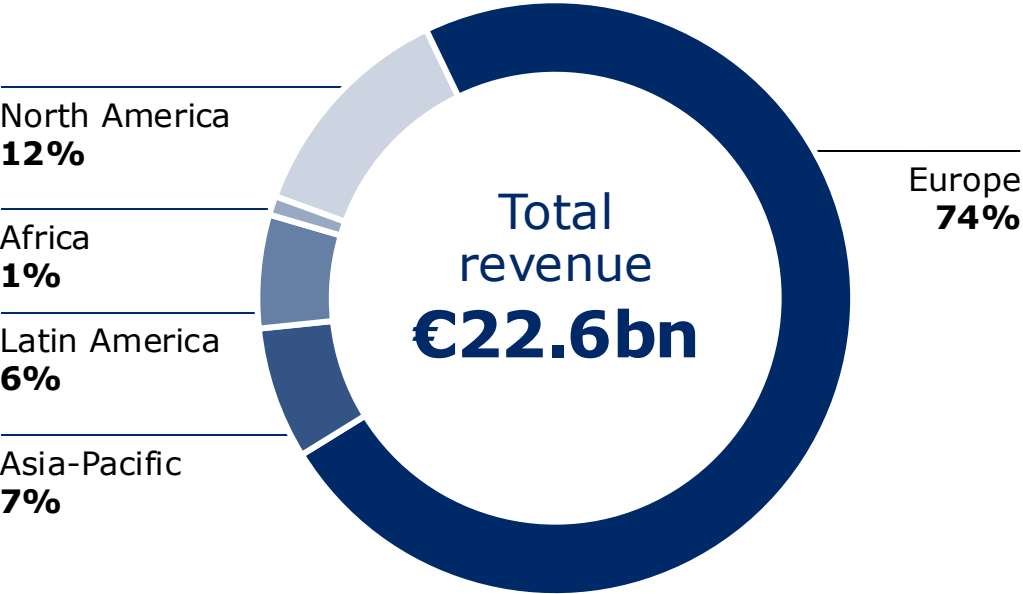

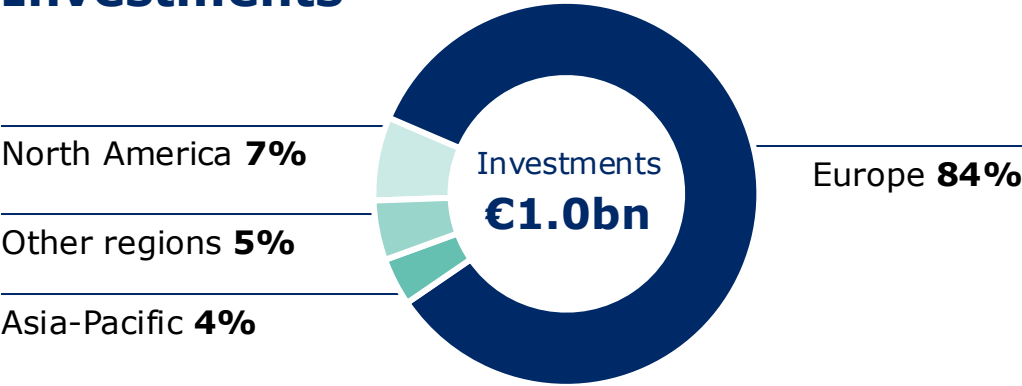

Regional split

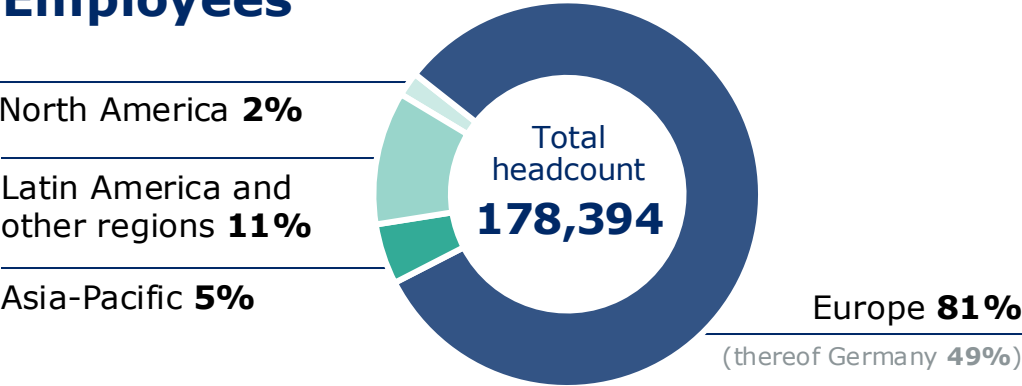

Innovations Robotics

Surgical robots

Fresenius Helios uses advanced robotic technology to make surgery less invasive and gentler for patients.

For example, prostate surgery previously required abdominal incisions of up to several centimeters. The new technology manages with small, millimeter-sized openings. This significantly accelerates recovery after surgery.

Innovations Cell and gene therapy

CAR T-cell therapy

Besides the well-known treatment options for cancer such as surgery, chemotherapy, and radiotherapy, there are now also highly advanced new methods.

One of the innovative approaches is known as CAR T-cell therapy, which is used at Helios Hospital Berlin-Buch, among other places.

This is a form of immunotherapy that uses the patient's defense cells to target and destroy malignant cells. Unlike standard chemo, it leaves healthy tissues and organs largely intact. CAR T-cell is a potential basis for personalized medicine.

Fresenius cooperates in innovation networks such as EASYGEN to advance breakthroughs in new treatment modalities.

You may be familiar with this: you fill out the same form half a dozen times at a clinic. It's a waste of time and resources.

To improve processes, we developed the **digital platform Casiopea** in-house. Patients use it to communicate with the clinic online 24/7.

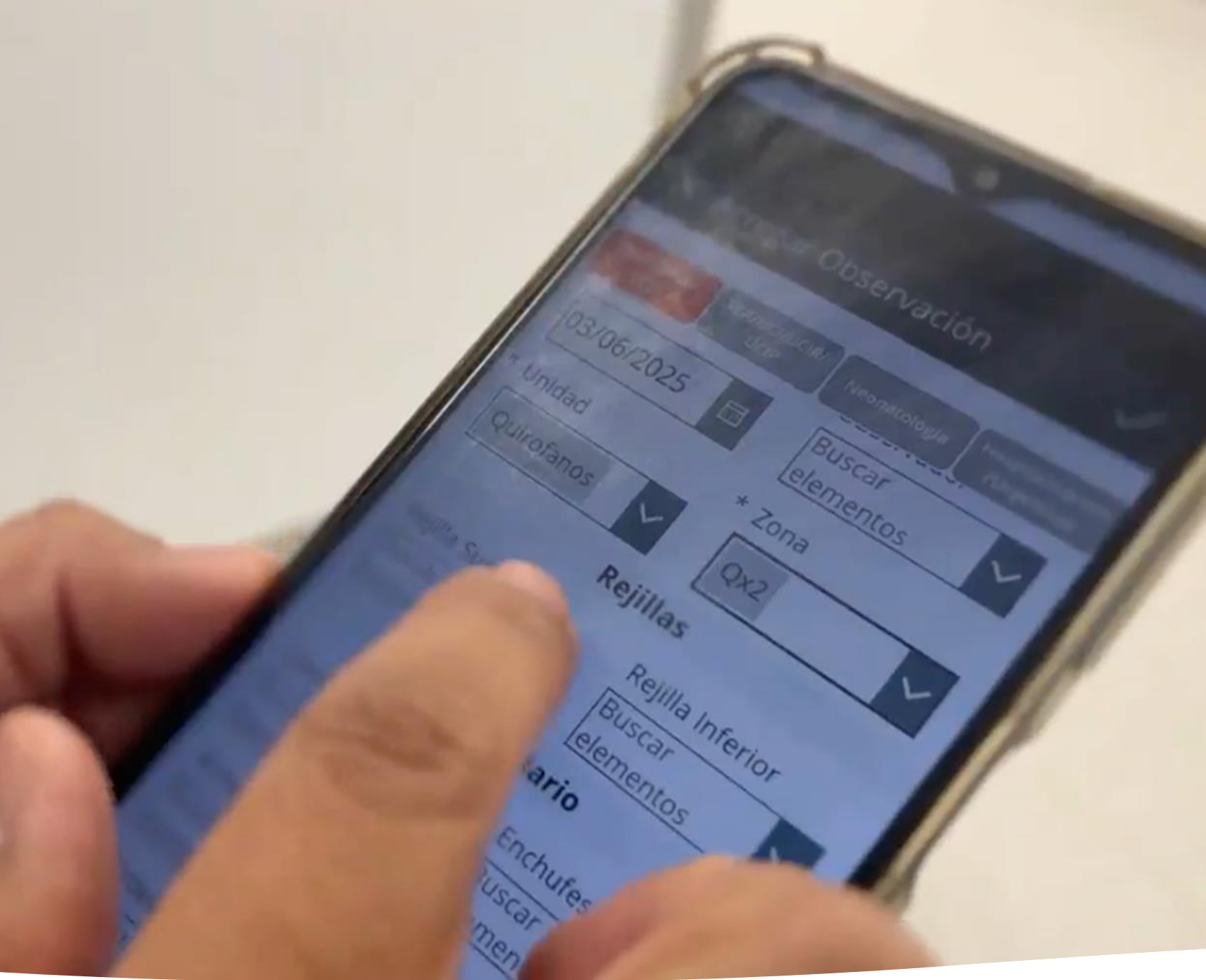

Innovations Artificial Intelligence

Casiopea uses AI to improve patient care.

The AI system **Salud** manages the treatment pathway, prevents duplicate tests, and reduces wait times.

With **Argos**, we have an AI-based monitoring platform that helps detect hospital-acquired infections early on, thereby saving lives.

The AI application **Scribe** automatically converts a doctor-patient conversation into clinical documentation.

Scribe: A pilot project becomes the standard

Ambient listening for enhanced care

Using generative AI, Scribe automatically records and analyzes doctor-patient conversations. The technology identifies relevant content, assists with inquiries and prescriptions, and streamlines documentation – all fully integrated into Casiopea. The result: more efficient processes, higher quality care, and more time for patients.

Scribe was launched as a pilot project in 2025 and is now standard in Quirónsalud facilities.

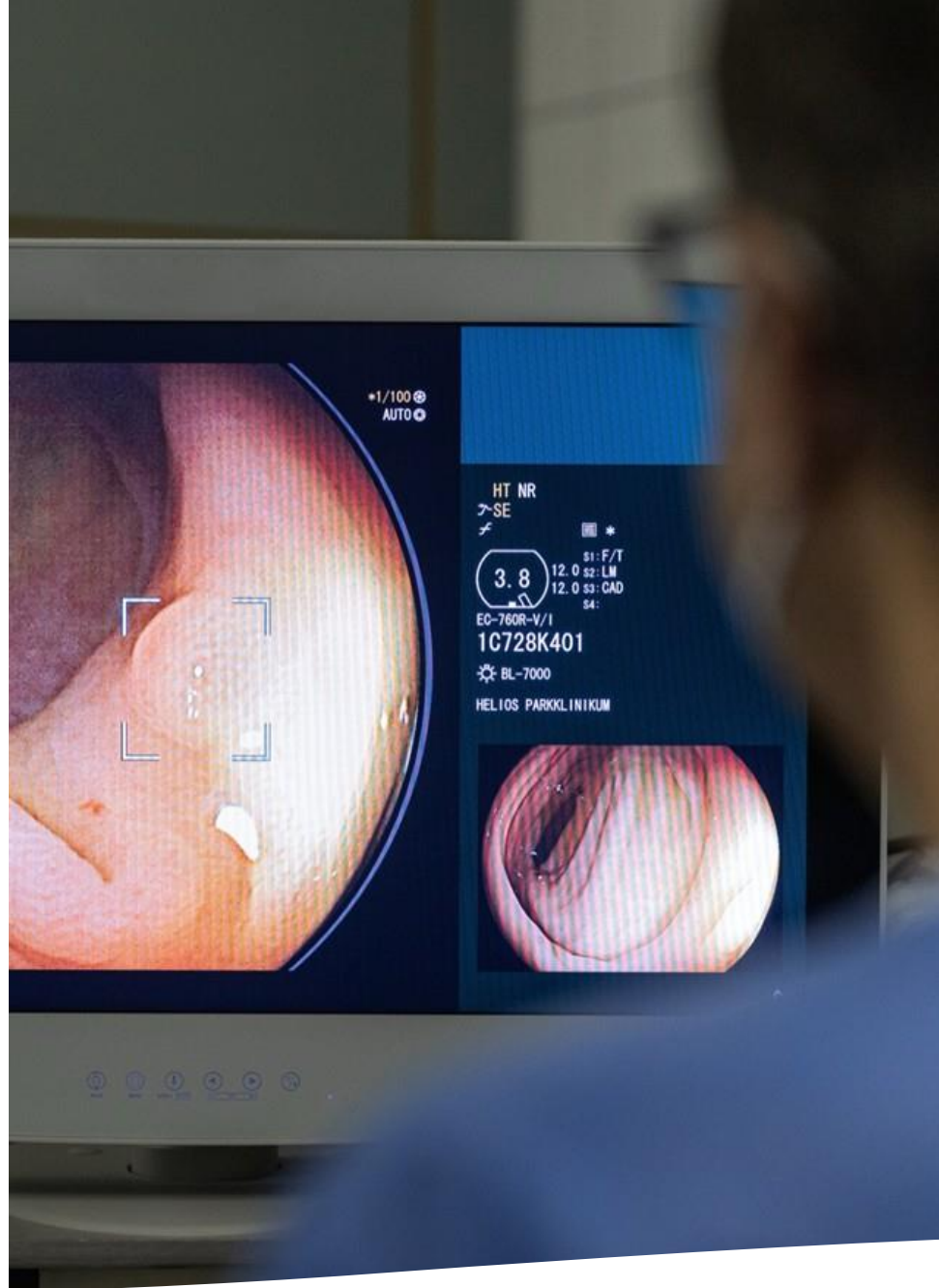
Colon cancer screening with AI

Colorectal cancer is a leading form of cancer in men and women and increasingly diagnosed in young adults worldwide. However, the risk of developing colon cancer can be reduced by regular screening.

The latest development in colonoscopies is the use of AI. An algorithm recognizes polyps in the intestinal mucosa during the endoscopy. AI does not replace doctors, but supports their diagnostics. It provides additional information that the human eye would miss.

Among other Fresenius Helios clinics, the Colon Cancer Center at Helios Park Hospital Leipzig is routinely using AI in the diagnosis of intestinal polyps.

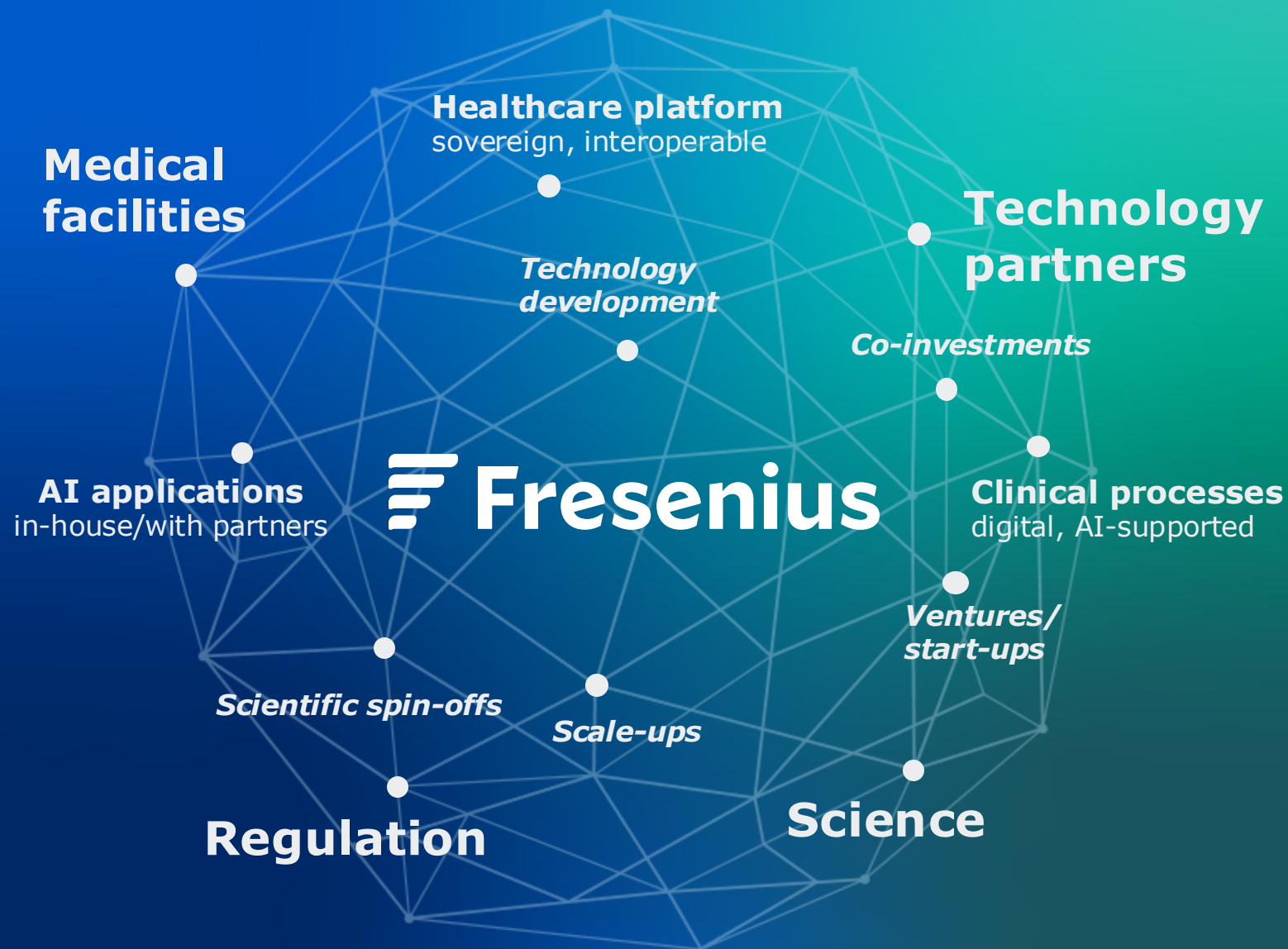
